1. Prepare for a future quiz on the Mysteries of the Rosary (Matching quiz - study guide below. Students should know what group of 5 events belongs to which Mystery)

- **The Joyful Mysteries**
 - The Annunciation
 - The Visitation
 - The Nativity or Birth of Jesus
 - The Presentation
 - The Finding of Jesus in the Temple
- **The Mysteries of Light or Luminous Mysteries**
 - The Baptism of Jesus in the River Jordan
 - The Wedding Feast at Cana or Miracle at Cana
 - The Proclamation of the Kingdom of Heaven
 - The Transfiguration of Jesus
 - The Institution of the Eucharist
- **The Sorrowful Mysteries**
 - The Agony in the Garden
 - The Scourging at the Pillar
 - The Crowning with Thorns
 - The Carrying of the Cross
 - The Crucifixion and Death of Our Lord
- **The Glorious Mysteries**
 - The Resurrection
 - The Ascension
 - The Descent of the Holy Spirit
 - The Assumption of Mary
 - The Coronation of Our Lady
