Deacon Mark Maines and Seminarians Michael Lewis and Ethan Gould will assist.** All are welcome to attend and to begin a year of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

The celebration will be held in the Church utilizing 50% of the Church capacity. Overflow seating will be arranged in Muldowney Hall where the Mass will be livestreamed. Please come upstairs at the time of Holy Communion. Ushers will assist.

Please note that we ask all participants to follow recommended health and safety protocols to keep each other safe and healthy.

• Please only sit in the open pews. Every other pew has been roped off. Households and families don't need to socially distance from

each other, but each household must have at least six feet of distance from another in the pew.

- **Masks must be worn** while entering and exiting the Church and while in the Communion line. Per the governor's specification that masks need not be worn during a religious ritual, you may remove your mask while seated in the pew as you will be socially distanced from other households.

After Mass, participants are asked to exit the Church directly. The bishop and visiting clergy will be located in the circle in front of the Church for socially distanced greeting and blessings. Come help begin a year of celebration and devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

FIRST READING _____ 1 Kings 3:5, 7-12
The LORD appeared to Solomon in a dream at night. God said, "Ask something of Me and I will give it to you." Solomon answered: "O LORD, my God, You have made me, Your servant, king to succeed my father David; but I am a mere youth, not knowing at all how to act.
